SPUYSC COVID-19 Protocol:

Mask Policy

The City of San Pablo requires all players, coaches, referees and spectators to wear face coverings while attending any event at the Rumrill Sports Park.

SPUYSC is responsible for informing all members, referees and all opposing clubs of this rule before attending any events at Rumrill Sports Park

Vaccination Policy

Any coach, player or spectator age 12 and over must show proof of vaccination, a medical exemption or religious exemption before entering the Rumrill Sports Park

COVID-19 Reporting & Tracking Protocols

If someone reports a positive COVID test and exposure has been identified (present at the program for 2 days prior to the date the test was taken), the following measures must be taken:

- Immediately remove player/coach from all team activities
- Report immediately to spuysc@gmail.com or to Rafael Torres 510-367-9335. Turn in roster with date and time of potential exposure along with anyone else who had contact such as coaches, volunteers.
- Inform all those that had contact in writing (do not disclose names) they have come into close contact with that person. Team registar holds the information and makes all the notifications.
- All players / coaches who had contact with the COVID positive person must enter a 10-day quarantine and <u>team does not play.</u>
- They will be asked to monitor symptoms for 14 days and must provide a negative COVID test taken at least 5 days after exposure to return to play.
- If anyone tests positive or has symptoms you must quarantine for **at least** 10 days or longer until you have been symptom free for 24 hours.
- You must provide a negative COVID test to return to play.

If anyone reports a verified close contact (within 6 feet for a cumulative time of 15 minutes) with someone who has a positive COVID test result and exposure has been identified (past two days to the time of the report):

- Submit a COVID-19 tracking sheet to spuysc@gmail.com or to Rafael Torres 510-367-9335
- That person does not return to play until they provide a negative COVID test at least 5 days after their exposure.
- Inform all those that exposure have been identified in writing (do not disclose names) of a possible secondary exposure to someone who tested positive for COVID.
- Have them monitor their symptoms for 14 days and encourage them to take a COVID test. If they display any COVID symptoms they must quarantine for at least 10 days since the onset of symptoms and be clear of any symptoms for 24 hours. They must provide a negative COVID t to return to play.

League Series responsibilities:

SPUYSC Responsibilities

- Provide face masks to all coaches
- Provide disinfecting equipment to all coaches to spray and clean equipment before and after games
- Provide sanitizer for coaches and referees
- Provide effective information and instructions to all before arriving at Rumrill Sports Park
- Effectively communicate public health information to notify adult leaders, players and families if the organization learns a participant or adult has developed COVID-19 while maintaining confidentiality
- Train and educate all staff/volunteers on protocols for return to play
- Be prepared to shut down and stop operations
- Provide adequate field space for social distancing on both players and spectators sidelines
- Ensure that everyone over the age of 12 is vaccinated before attending any games at Rumrill Sports Park

Coaches Responsibilities:

- Model safe behavior for all players to follow
- Wear mask/face covering at all times
- Require all participants ages 2 and older to wear a mask.
- Confirm any player age 12 and older has been vaccinated.
- Inquire how each athlete is feeling, send them home should you believe they act or look ill
- Follow all club, City of San Pablo, state and federal health protocols at all times
- Report confirmed cases of COVID-19 immediately to spuysc@gmail.com or to Rafael Torres
 510-367-9335 and cease trainings and games
- Keep attendance of players attending games (including the opposing teams) to assist with tracking and tracing cases of COVID-19

- Ensure all athletes use their own equipment
- Limit equipment brought to games and disinfect all equipment before / after use
- Ensure social distancing per state and local guidelines.
- Do not allow players to share pennies, other equipment, or water bottles

Team Managers:

- Require any spectator entering Rumrill Sports Park to wear a mask and show proof of vaccination if they are over 12 years old.
- Monitor social distancing on sidelines by spectators
- Monitor congregating of parents at the fields or in the parking lot pregame, halftime, or postgame
- Send out communication (text/email) to parents prior to games reminding them of mask and proof of vaccination requirements.

Spectators / Guardians / Players:

- Only sit in designated spectator areas (same as regular league matches)
- No congregating on sidelines or in parking lot before, during, or after matches
- Sit a minimum of 10ft off sideline
- Under no circumstances can a parent approach or be in the designated team area
- Anyone ages 2 and older must wear a mask at all times.
- Anyone age 12 and older must show proof of vaccination.
- Report confirmed cases of COVID-19 or symptoms immediately to spuysc@gmail.com or to Rafael Torres 510-367-9335 and quarantine for at least 10 days
- Report any positive COVID case
- Stay home if you have any signs or symptoms of being sick
- If you are a person of high risk, do not attend
- Symptom check their players before arriving at field
- Try to avoid contact with any players or spectators outside of your households
